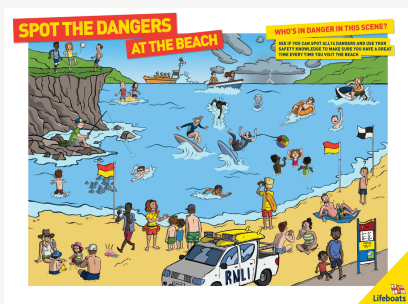

As you know the STEM on Track National Finals took place on Saturday 20 June, at Whilton Mill Race Circuit.

Working in teams, they have designed and built their own go-karts from scratch, passed their driving tests, successfully navigated scrutineering to ensure their karts were race-ready, overcome numerous engineering and mechanical challenges, and demonstrated exceptional resilience, teamwork, problem-solving and determination throughout the process.

We were also delighted that there was a Q&A session featuring our CEO, Nicole McCarty, alongside representatives from Alpine Formula 1. They were discussing the challenges of designing and racing an F1 car, as well as exploring the parallels between leading high-performing teams in motorsport and leading schools.

The day was a wonderful example of applied learning in action and provided a fantastic opportunity to see our students thriving, developing confidence, and bringing classroom learning to life.

Celebrating Student Achievements

We are delighted to share some fantastic news about our students' achievements this term. So far, an impressive 2,317 rewards have been awarded—an outstanding reflection of students' effort, engagement, and positive attitudes to learning. A special congratulations goes to our Year 7 students, who are leading the way with an incredible 715 rewards already this term—what a fantastic achievement. Year 8 students are also performing very well, with Year 9 close behind and just 80 rewards away—an exciting challenge we are confident they will rise to. It is especially pleasing to see that Independence continues to be the value most frequently recognised, closely followed by Engagement. This focus is having a clear and positive impact across the school. In fact, the number of students requiring reflection sessions (RESET) has reduced by 53% over a 10-day period, demonstrating that students are increasingly focused, engaged, and thriving in their learning.
