ALLERGY AWARENESS BENEDICT'S LAW



ALLERGY AWARENESS

We are writing to inform you about the implementation of Benedict's Law at Weavers Academy. Following national guidelines, we are strengthening our safeguards to protect the health, wellbeing, and safety of all children with severe allergies.





DEDICATED POLICY:

We are implementing a comprehensive whole-school allergy policy to ensure every child with a known allergy is supported, protected, and included in all aspects of school life.

LIFE-SAVING MEDICATION:

We will now be maintaining and have readily accessible spare emergency adrenaline auto-injectors (e.g., EpiPens) on-site at all times to respond swiftly in the event of a severe allergic reaction.





STAFF TRAINING:

All school staff are receiving compulsory training to recognize the signs of anaphylaxis and administer emergency medication safely and confidently when needed.

IHCPs

If your child has a serious allergy this will be included in their Individual Health Care Plan (IHCP) which we will contact you about in due course
