The only way to top-up your child's account will be through the on-line facility, Parent-Pay or any convenience store or supermarket where the PayPoint logo is displayed.

If you have not already activated your Parent-Pay/Point-Point account then please contact me for details. The new Year 7's will receive theirs by 4 September 2020.

I am expecting a large volume of requests and will reply to you as soon as I can.

If you have forgotten your password, you can re-set it via Parent-Pay on the home screen.

Dinner Money

The Canteen have agreed a maximum £5 overdraft per student. This means that your child will be able to purchase food and drink items even if you have not had the opportunity to top-up on-line.

If you do not wish your child to have this facility then please contact me and it can be removed. Once an account has been topped up, any dinner money owing will be deducted from your child's account.

School Items for Purchase

We can no longer accept cash payments into Reception, Finance or Student Office.

Any stationery items you wish to purchase will be available on Parent-Pay and can be collected from the Student Office

The items currently available are pens, pencils, rulers, calculators and new school ties. Additional items will be added to Parent-Pay in due course with a direction stated as to how it can be collected or if it will be delivered.
