Exam results day 2021

I hope that you are all well. Please find below the arrangements for the communication of examination results on Tuesday 10th August 2021 for A-Level and Level 3 Courses (Post 16 Students) and Thursday 12th August 2021 for GCSEs (Year 11 Students). The process this year will be different as you are already aware and has to be managed sensitively and safely compared to previous years.

A level and Level 3 vocational qualifications – 10th August 2021

Results will be available to students electronically via Edulink from 8.30am on Tuesday 10th August 2021. From the main Edulink menu students should click on the 'Exams' icon and then click on the 'Exam Results' tab which will appear at 8.30am on 10th August 2021.

Mrs Sexsmith and senior staff will be available onsite from 9am on the 10th August 2021 to offer support and guidance regarding university applications, next steps and to respond to any enquiries about results.

Year 12 students - Unless you have a specific query about your results, we are expecting you to get your results via Edulink.

GCSE and Level 1 and 2 vocational qualifications – 12th August 2021

Results will be available to students electronically via Edulink from 8.30am on Thursday 12th August 2021. From the main Edulink menu, students should click on the 'Exams' icon and then click on the 'Exam Results' tab which will appear at 8.30am on 12th August 2021.

Mr Higgins, Mrs McRae-Smith and other senior staff will be available from 9am on 12th August 2021 to offer support and guidance about next steps, including entry to the sixth form at Weavers Academy and to respond to any enquiries about results.

Students who have made an application to Sixth Form at Weavers Academy will have an offer letter available on Edulink or in their results envelope on the day.

If you choose to collect your examination results in person on **either day**, you will do so from Weavers Leisure centre on Weavers Road. No access will be granted via the Brickhill Road entrance

In light of this, here is how you will need to collect your results:

- You will be the only person allowed on the school site to collect your results. Your parents/carers/friends are not allowed to come onto the



school site to help maintain social distancing. You can only attend during your allocated time slot. We are unfortunately unable to allow you to collect them at another time during the day so please check the time carefully.

- When you arrive, you will be asked to follow the school's safety procedures including maintaining social distancing from staff/students and sanitising hands on entry and exit.
- It is also important that you have completed a lateral flow test prior to collecting your results in person – Testing kits are available from the School's main reception.

If you cannot access Edulink currently, please click on the link below: <https://www.edulinkone.com> Once you have accessed the Edulink website you will have a choice of using either a code or a postcode to logon. Please use 'weavers' or 'NN8 3JH'. Then use your normal main school login to access your own results.

Re-sitting examinations

As you may be aware, students are entitled to resit their examinations should they wish to in the autumn term. Any students who wish to appeal their Level 2 result must complete the form enclosed in the results envelope on results day or attached in Edulink and return it by 3rd September 2021 to examinationappeals2021@weaversacademy.org.uk for a Centre review.
