## Mass Testing for January 2022

You may be aware that the Department for Education has issued updated Covid- Trust 19 guidance for schools.

Schools are being asked to implement mass testing arrangements for students on the return to school in January 2021. All schools have been asked to test students once on site. Testing for students at Weavers will take place on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> January. The academy will then open as normal for all students on Thursday 6th January.

Whilst the government is encouraging all students and staff to be tested before their return, participation is voluntary and can only take place if consent is given.

We therefore ask that all parents/carers complete the Microsoft Form linked below to tell us whether you are giving or declining consent to test; on this occasion an email will not be sufficient.

All students need to arrive with a facemask at the time indicated. **Once their test** is complete, students will be allowed to leave site and return home.

The current advice is that students should then continue to test twice weekly at home until the Government has reviewed the guidance in the New Year and have decided it is no longer necessary.
